

APAC SUMMER PROGRAMS 2021 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Where do the camps take place?

Camps take place in the theater at APAC at 150 Avenel Street, Avenel, NJ 07001.

Can I participate in both programs?

Yes!

Is lunch provided?

No. Students participating must bring their own lunch. They will have time in between programs to eat (12pm-1pm.)

What are the dates and times?

The Triple Threat Workshop Camp runs Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays from July 27-August 20. The times are 9am-12pm. We will accept a maximum of 20 students in this program.

The Broadway, Jr. Show Camp runs Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays from July 27-August 20. The times are 1pm-4pm. We will accept a maximum of 20 students in this program.

What will the Triple Threat Workshop Camp study?

Geared for students who want to build their performance skills, this camp will focus on the three pillars of theater, Singing, Dancing, and Acting. Each hour will be dedicated to one of the disciplines. There will be an informal showcase on the last day of camp, Friday, August 20 from 11am-12pm. All students in this program will perform in the showcase.

What will the Broadway, Jr. Show Camp study?

This camp will focus on the final production, the show! Students will rehearse for three hours to perform a Broadway, Jr. show (title still being determined.) The show will be performed for family, friends, and the surrounding community on Friday, August 20 at a time TBD. All students in this program will perform in the show.

What are the age requirements?

The Triple Threat Workshop Camp is for ages 9-13.

The Broadway, Jr. Show Camp is for ages 9-16.

Who are the teachers?

The main teacher is Carrie Rubino, Marketing Manager at The Avenel Performing Arts Center. Carrie has been working in professional theater for the past 20 years. Previously, Carrie was the Senior Manager of Education Programs at the Tony Award winning regional theater, Paper Mill Playhouse. At Paper Mill, she managed the Adopt-A-School Project and the state-wide Rising Star Awards. She also taught numerous classes for the Summer Musical Theater Conservatory and Theater School. Students of Carrie have appeared in national tours, tv shows, movies, regional theater, commercials, voice over, and Broadway shows such as The King and I, School of Rock,

Beautiful: The Carole King Musical, Matilda, Les Misérables, and The Radio City Christmas Spectacular, amongst others. As the current Marketing Manager at The Avenel Performing Arts Center, she is excited to bring her skill set to a new community so that more students are afforded the opportunity to fall in love with performing.

Other teachers will be announced shortly including a choreographer and music director.

How do I register?

How much are the camps?

The Triple Threat Workshop Camp is \$875 for the full four weeks.

The Broadway, Jr. Show Camp is \$975 for the full four weeks.

Partial scholarships are available for students who prove need. Scholarship information will be emailed on Thursday, June 17, 2021.

What are your COVID protocols and procedures?

Policies will be emailed to those students that register. As of now, face masks are required for campers that are unvaccinated. Social distancing will be observed to the best of our abilities. These rules and guidelines, as mandated by the state of NJ, may change and we will update you as soon as possible.

We have a vacation planned. Can my child miss classes?
